IND 2104: INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY CAPSTONE

This course provides an opportunity for students to demonstrate mastery of a broad range of learning objectives and outcomes from the Industrial Technology program at UACCB. The course provides instruction in process control and control fundamentals and presents students with problems requiring teamwork and integration of previous learning in electrical, mechanical, and electronics disciplines. Course assessments focus on application of applicable theory, requiring analysis and synthesis of Industrial Technology knowledge and skills in a laboratory environment. The course also focuses on Industrial Technology as a career by preparing students for employment through online job searches, preparation of resumes, site visits, and job fairs.
